CLARIFICATION

It is noticed that there is confusion amongst students / parents about continuation fee structure till completion of the course. Their attention is invited to Section 14 (6) of the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and Fees) Act, 2015 which reads as under :

"(6) The fees approved and communicated by the Fees Regulating Authority shall be applicable in respect of the candidate who is admitted to the unaided institution in that academic year and shall not be revised till the completion of the course of such student in the concerned institution."

It is thus clear that fee structure declared by this Authority for the batch of students of particular academic year, shall remain same till completion of course by the students of that batch. For e.g. if fees for A.Y. 2017-18 batch in a particular institution, for particular course is declared as Rs. 50,000/- and course is of 4 years – then, fee of Rs. 50,000/- per annum, shall be same till completion of entire course. No increase is permissible. If any institution collects / demands more than such declared fees, online complaint can be lodged with this Authority.
