Item No. 3(a) : **To consider and decide on proposals where discrepancies were pointed out and are cleared by the Colleges/Institutes.**

The Samiti considered the proposals of the following Colleges/Institutes for finalization of fee structure for the students who joined the course started during Academic Year 2012-13. After deliberations, the Samiti decides to approve the final fee structure of the following Institutes/Colleges for the students who joined the course started during Academic Year 2012-13. Figures are arrived at after considering the calculations drawn in the worksheet – calculation sheets of the respective colleges/institutes prepared by a Chartered Accountant. The students admitted in the Academic Year 2012-13 and there after continuing their studies will pay an enhanced fee of 8% each successive year as per the norms for 2012-13 till completion of the course, For example if the fee approved is Rs. 1,00,000/- then 2nd year, 3rd year and 4th year's student will be Rs. 1,08,000/-. After deliberation, Samiti decides to the College viz. MB3109 : S.I.E.S. College of Management Studies, Mumbai and MC3109 : S.I.E.S. College of Management Studies, Mumbai under Audit of the Samiti. Fees of the said Colleges/Institutes to be finalized thereafter.

Item No. 4(a) : To consider and decide the Review Applications received from following Colleges for fixation of fees for Academic Year 2012-13

1) EN3195 : Parshwanath College of Engineering, Thane

It is observed that the aforesaid College/Institute is closed. Therefore, there is no question of review/revision in fee fixed by the Samiti for Academic Year 2012-13

2) EN3188 : Padmabhushan Vasantdada Patil Pratishthan's College of Engineering, Mumbai

Samiti heard Dr. K.T. Reddy, Principal and Mr. Sanjay Sathe, Chartered Accountant on behalf of the aforesaid College/Institute

As per our resolution notice given to the Students/Parents by the College/Institute, but none is present on behalf of students/parents. Notice is produced.

Samiti has decided to recheck the accounts of the said College/Institute. Samiti also asked it to produce certain documents in respect of salary expenditure and details regarding expenditure involved where the item is more than Rs. 5 Lacs. Fee to be finalized thereafter.

3) AR6261 : Dr. Bhanuben Nanavati College of Architecture for Women, Pune

Samiti heard Dr. Anurag Kashyap, Principal and A. Mahajan, Dy. Accountant on behalf of the aforesaid College/Institute

As per our resolution College/Institute has given notice to the Students/Parents, but none is present on behalf of students/parents. The copy thereof is produce.

It is in respect of B. Architecture course for the Academic Year 2012-13. The fee approved by the Samiti is Rs. 82,340/-. The Institute has originally demanded Rs. 91,400/-. The fee during Academic course 2011-12 was Rs. 85,000/-. The Institute was raised the points (i) The infrastructure expenses are excluded and this was an error, There is substance in it. (ii) Second point raised is regarding excluding Management charges. These are in respect of common facility for B. Architecture and M. Architecture course. Prapositionally they should be included. We also pointed out to the Institute regarding certain additions wrongly made to expenditure. The Institute has now given letter dated 7th February 2013 stating that they may be allow fee of Rs. 88,000/- for the said course (wrongly mention as 2011-12 in the letter). We feel that it is quite reasonable. Hence we finalize the fee of Rs. 88,000/- for the students who joined the course for B. Architecture during the Academic Year 2012-13. Office to take steps accordingly.



4) **EN6303 : G.K. Gujar Memorial Charitable Trust, Dr. Daulatrao Aher College of Engineering, Karad**

Samiti heard Dr. Ajay V. Deshmukh, Principal and Mr. B.R. Sawant, Chartered Accountant on behalf of the aforesaid College/Institute

As per our resolution aforesaid College/Institute has given notice to the Students/Parents and Hemangi B. Gawade (3rd Year C.S.E) and Pawar S. Mayur (3rd Year E. & T.C.) students are present. But they are not concerned and give in writing.

We examined the position regarding Point. No. 4only raised. The College was satisfied with our explanation. Hence prayed for withdrawal. Allowed to withdraw the review/ revision filed by the aforesaid College/Institute.

Item No. 4(b) : To consider and decide the Review Application received from following College for fixation of fees for Academic Year 2011-12.

1) **MB5126 : Ozar Vikas Sanstha's Vishwasattya College of MBA, Ozar.**

The review/revision is filed for the finalisation of fee for the course started during Academic Year 2011-12. It is filed on 30/10/2012.

Hence there was delay. The College is explain it. Samiti to give the hearing on next date of the Meeting to the said College. The College also to give a notice to students/parents as per our resolution. After receipt of the same, it is to be placed before Samiti in its next meeting. Office to take steps accordingly.

Item No. 5 : To consider and decide on letter received:-

Item No. 5(a) : Complaint dated 10/12/2012 received from Ramesh Gophne regarding excess fees collected from the students for Academic Year 2006 to 2012 of Walchand Institute of Technology, Solapur. (Ref. : Agenda Item No. 5(d) of meeting dated 9th January 2013)

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Samiti heard Dr. S.A. Halkude - Principal, Mr. R.Y. Rawal – Registrar, Mr. Chaitanya Randive - Allumini student, Nikhil Nandgaonkr - Allumini Student, Mr. Ramesh R. Gophne.

Admittedly Mr. Gofne who has made this complaint was not the students of the Walchand Institute of Technology, Solapur. He was a student of Shri Vithal Education and Research Institute's College of Engineering, Pandharpur. In fact he joined the College in Academic Year 2005-06 and completed the course in Academic Year 2008-09.



He filed suit against the said College in Civil Court, Pandharpur bearing No. 18 of 2011 alleging that excess fee was charge and it is pending. It is also pointed out now the complainant has given notice to the College through Advocate and College has given reply through Advocate. It is also pointed out that The Institute has pointed out in its reply filed before the Samiti on 11/12/2012 that the Association of the Management of Private Unaided Technical Institutes in Maharashtra being Writ Petition No. 4469 of 2009 in the High Court of Bombay, Bench at Aurangabad. This Institute is a member of the said Association and it has challenged various decisions of the Samiti before High Court. The complainant has not even explained the delay in making this complains so late which creates suspicion about his motive.

When the hearing was going on Mr. Nikhil Nandgaonkar pointed out that he made complaint on 11/07/2012 to the Samiti regarding charging of excess fee. He joined this college during the Academic Year 2006-07 and passed out during Academic Year 2010-11 and perusal of his application shows that he was claiming excess fees. Now he stated he paid much fee in excess in all the four years. He has also not explained the delay in coming to this Samiti after getting though the course.

Considering the various aspects and for more, that one reason, we reject the complaints.

Item No. 5(b) : Letter dated 31/12/2012 received from Shri Adesh Janai regarding proposal submitted by Appsaheb Birnale College of Architecture, Sangli (Ref.: Agenda Item No. 5(f) of meeting dated 9th January 2013).

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Samiti heard Mr. V.B. Sambrekar – I/c Principal and Adesh J. Jani.

Considered the letter dated 31/12/2012 received from Shri Adesh Janai. We heard both the sides. We also perused the reply of the Institute. After deliberation, complaint prayed to allow to withdraw. Allowed to withdraws.

Item No. 5(c) : Letter dated 3/1/2013 and 14/12/2012 received from K.C. College of Engineering and Management Studies and Research, Thane regarding refund of fees to Mr. Thakur Zain Mohammad and Ku. Ajinkya More.

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

After deliberation, we decide to consider the said matter in the next meeting. Meanwhile office to call the details from the Directorate of Technical Education, Maharashtra State in respect of these two students - viz. Ku. Thakur Zain Mohammad Tahir and Ku. Ajinkya Gorakhnath More mentioned in the aforesaid letter dated 3/1/2012 and 14/12/2012 regarding following points:-

- i) List of admitted candidates in Academic Year 2012-13 along with dates of admissions.
- ii) Total Sanctioned Intake Capacity for the Academic Year 2012-13.
- iii) Admission dates, cancellation dates and cut-off-date.

After receipt of the same, it be placed before Samiti for its consideration.

Item No. 6 : **To consider letter dated 17/01/2013 received from Joint Secretary, Higher and Technical Education Department, Mantralaya, Mumbai regarding fixation of fees for Higher Education Courses (B.Ed./B.P.Ed./M.Ed./M.P.Ed.)**

Samiti considered the letter dated 17th January 2013 addressed of to the Samiti by Joint Secretary, Higher and Technical Education, Maharashtra State in respect of approving fees of B.Ed., M.Ed., B.P.Ed. and M.P.Ed. courses. It is not possible for the Samiti since there is already decision given by Hon'ble High Court – Nagpur Bench giving the directions in that case regarding establishment of new Samiti for fixation of fees for said courses. The Government has to comply with it. It is also learn that Government move the Hon'ble High Court in that case to extend the time for establishment of such Samiti.

Considering this it is not possible to decide the fees for such courses. If this Samiti decides the fee structure of the said courses, then it may amount of violating the direction of the Hon'ble High Court in other cases and land it in contempt. Office to communicate.

Item No. 7 : **To consider the letter dated 10/01/2013 received from Under Secretary, Higher and Technical Education Department, Mantralaya, Mumbai regarding meeting in Mantralaya for fixation of norms for Academic Year 2013-14.**

Samiti considered the letter dated 10th January 2013 addressed to the Samiti by Under Secretary, Higher and Technical Education, Maharashtra State.

After deliberation, Samiti decides that suggested points can be taken into consideration at the time of finalizing norms for the course starting during Academic Year 2013-14. These shall be 'Open Hearing' and both sides i.e. students/parents and Colleges/Institutes can be heard and norms can be finalized. This shall take place in month of March. Office to communicate the same.

Item No. 8 : **To consider the following:**

Item No. 8(a) : **Letter dated 23/01/2013 received from Association of Unaided Management Institutes offering PGDM/Post Graduate Management Programmes, Pune regarding fixation of fee structure for PGDM courses.**

Samiti considered the letter dated 23rd January 2013 addressed to it by the Association of Unaided Management Institutes offering PGDM/Post-Graduate

Management Programme. Unfortunately the letter has not quoted the complete para No. 2 of the order dated 17th March 2011 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi in Writ Petition (Civil) No(s). 89 of 2011 in the matter of Jaipuria Institute of Management and Ors versus All India Council for Technical Education and Others. The Complete para reads as under: -

"The PGDM institutions will be entitled to charge the fees that is determined by them, subject to the fee structure being notified to AICTE and the State Governments in advance. Subject to the final decision in this case, the State Government will be at liberty to send the fee structures of the respective institutions to the fee fixation committee that may be appointed in terms of the guidelines in the handbook for its decision/opinion."

The Association stopped at the word 'advance' and pointed out only the favorable part ignoring rest. The reading of the entire para makes it clear that wherever there is Shikshan Shulka Samiti established by the State Government. The State Government has to send it to the said Samiti for approval of fees proposed by the Institute. Hence it is rejected.

Item No. 8(b): Letter received from following Institutes/Colleges giving clarification for non submission of proposal for PGDM course for Academic Year 2012-13.

- i) **Thakur Institutes of Management Studies and Research, Kandivali, Mumbai**
- ii) **K.J. Somaiya Institutes of Management Studies and Research, Vidyavihar, Mumbai**

Samiti perused the letters under reference.

After deliberation, Samiti decides that for the reasons mention in Item No. 8(a), we reject this letter for the same reason.

iii) **Sinhgad Technical Education Society, Pune**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

The Institute has pointed out that the PGDBM courses has been stopped in the said letter dated 23/01/2013. They have not admitted any student in Academic Year 2012-13 for the course.

Samiti notes it.
