The students admitted in Academic Year 2012-13 and there after continuing their studies will pay an enhanced fee of 5% each successive year as per the norms for 2012-13 till completion of the course. For example if the fee approved is Rs. 1,00,000/- then 2nd year, 3rd year and 4th year's student of the Health Science Colleges will be Rs. 1,05,000/-. (Assuming course is of 4 years). Item No. 6: To consider and decide on the letters received**Item No. 6(a): Letter dated 26/12/2012 received from Police Inspector, Economic Offences wing, Amravati citing violation of Capitation Fees Act by Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh Medical College, Amravati**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

The parents/students have approach this Samiti earlier. Even they have approached the Hon'ble High Court thereafter. In view of the order passed by the Hon'ble High Court they were heard through the Advocate. The matter then decided and all the points raised were not only before the Samiti, but also before the High Court. The Samiti decided then again. Thereafter they approached Hon'ble Governor of State of Maharashtra and the Vice-Chancellor of Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik wrote a letter to the Samiti. This was considered by the Samiti on 26th November 2011 and the resolution passed. All the annexure were mark to the said resolution and it was sent to the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik. Thereafter they are approaching political parties and also Police. Perhaps suppressing all this with oblique motive and raising different frivolous points which were never raised either before Hon'ble High Court and before the Samiti. They are making all this to pressurize. The resolution dated 26/11/2012 is annexed herewith with all the annexures. It contains all the earlier proceedings and the said resolution is self explanatory. Office to send this resolution to the concerned Police Inspector.

If there is any grievance regarding charging of capitation fees then they have to approach State Government under section 6(1) of the Maharashtra Education Institute (Prohibition Capitation) 1987. Department of Medical Education and Drugs Department, Government of Maharashtra has issued a detailed Government resolution dated 12/10/2012 in that respect. Para 4 and 5 thereof are clear in this respect. We are herewith annexing said resolution.

Item No. 6(b): Letter dated 6/12/2012 received from Bhalchandra School of Nursing, Pune citing non approval of INC for RGNM course for AY 2012-13.

Samiti considered the letter dated 6th December 2012 received from Bhalchandra School of Nursing , Pune

It is stated that there was no admission during 2012-13. Hence there is no question of approval of fees for the Academic Year 2012-13. As far as old batches are concerned, fee earlier approved have to be charged for the entire course. Office to communicate the same.

Samiti considered the aforesaid letter.

We quote from the division bench judgment of Nagpur bench of the Hon'ble High Court dated 2nd August 2012 in writ petition No. 3251 of 2012, 3252 of 2012 and 3316 of 2012. It is enterially observed as follows.

In our view, therefore, the communications that are issued by the Maharashtra Nursing Council will not in any way mean that those who have appeared for eh examination or enrolled in the Academic Year 2011-12 and those who are entering the Nursing Institutions and Colleges established by the petitioners will, in any manner, not be permitted to pursue their studies. The Petitioners will have to comply with the terms and conditions of the provisional certificates and permissions so also the conditions stipulated in the essentiality Certificate. Until and unless they do so, they would not be in a position to contend that the permissions granted in their favour are absolute and, therefore, in no way the students or their academic pursuits will be affected in future, if proper compliances are made by the petitioners.

Then after admitting the petitions, it is stated

"In the light of our prima facie conclusions and subject to the petitioners complying with the terms and condition of the above noted communications, we permit them to admit students to the respective course in the Academic Session 2012-13."

It is not clear from said letters whether these four colleges complied the said terms and conditions. The Association to state the same. After receiving the compliance from the Association, office to put up the same before the Samiti.
