The Samiti considered the proposals of the following Colleges/ Institutes for finalization of fee structure for the students who joined the courses started during Academic year 2012-13. After deliberations, the Samiti decides to approve the final fee structure of the following Institutes/Colleges for the students who joined the course started during AY 2012-13. The students admitted in the AY 2012-13 and there after continuing their studies will pay an enhanced fee of 5% each successive year as per the norms for 2012-13 till completion of the course. For example if the fee approved is Rs. 1,00,000/- then 2nd year, 3rd year and 4th year's student of the Health Science colleges will be Rs. 1,05,000/- (assuming course is of 4 years)

The Samiti decides to re-audit at least five colleges every year through independent C.A./Auditor wherever any doubt arises in respect of the fee proposal submitted by it. And if any doubt is found to be appropriate then any Hon'ble Member along with one Auditor/C.A. to visit the said college to verify.. The expenses thereof to be borne by the Samiti and the members of the visiting team shall be entitled to travel either by economy airfare or by second class A.C. The fee to be finally approved after the said process is over.

- (b) **To consider and decide on letter dated 1st November 2012 received from Registrar, Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik regarding Irrational hike in tuition fees of Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh Memorial Medical College, Amravati accompanied by a letter from the Office of Secretary to the Governor No. MUHS.38/12/D/3792 dated 15th Oct. 2012 along with the complaint letter from Shri S. P. Sarnaik, Chairman Parents Asso. Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh Memorial Medical College, Amravati dated 3rd October 2012.**

Considered the letter dated 1st October 2012 received from Registrar, Maharashtra University of Health Science, Nashik. Similarly, considered the letter dated 15th October 2012 from Under Secretary to the Governor (Education) No. MUHS/38/12/D/3792 along with letter dated 3rd October 2012 from Shri S.P. Sarnaik, Chairman, Parents Association of Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh Memorial Medical College, Amravati. At the outset, we state that resolution Item No. 6 was passed by the Samiti in the meeting held on 7th November 2012. In view of the letter received from Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Maharashtra University of Health Science, Nashik Dr. Arun Jamkar dated 10th October 2012. We annexed No.1 the same herewith.

It is further to be noted that the matter was heard first on 30th November 2011 (Item No. 5 (1) and the order was passed. The order is annexed No.2 herewith.

There after the matter was taken to the Hon'ble High Court of Bombay at Nagpur Bench by filing the W.P. No. 1232 of 2011 on behalf of students/parents of the said college and the Hon'ble Court passed the order on 18th June 2012. Hhere to annexed No. 3 is the copy of the said order.

There was a revision filed on behalf of the student/parents before the Samiti. Here to annexed No.4 the copy of the said revision.

There after, the Samiti heard to parents/students as well as the institute. In fact, on behalf of the student one advocate appeared. After hearing both the



sides, detailed resolution bearing Item No. 4 (a) was passed on 16th July 2012. Here to annexed No. 4 is the copy of the said resolution.

All these facts are suppressed by the said Shri S.P. Sarnaik while writing the letter mentioned above. We have clarified time and again the difference between the interim fee declared and the final fee approved by the Samiti. The final fee is approved after considering the audited accounts and other connected papers as per norms of the Samiti applicable to all. The accounts are submitted to I.T. Department and also to the Charity Commissioner. Interim fee is declared 7% above the previous year's fee. It is required to be collected for bearing initial expenses of the college. The expenses of running a college are going up every year due to various increases and 6th pay payment.


