After deliberations, The Samiti decides to approve the final fee structure of the following Colleges/Institutes for the students who joined the course started during Academic Year 2012-13. Figures are arrived at after considering the calculations drawn in the worksheet – calculation sheets of the respective colleges/institutes prepared by a Chartered Accountant. The students admitted in Academic Year 2012-13 and there after continuing their studies will pay an enhanced fee of 5% each successive year as per the norms for 2012-13 till completion of the course. For example if the fee approved is Rs. 1,00,000/- then 2<sup>nd</sup> year, 3<sup>rd</sup> year and 4<sup>th</sup> year's student of the Health Science Colleges will be Rs. 1,05,000/- (Assuming course is of 4 years). Our Hon'ble Member Shri S.B. Bhagwat put certain cross questions to the party.

There upon it is stated that it would like to withdraw the revision. Allow to withdraw.

**Item No. 4(2): RGNM – Pratibha Institute of Nursing, Navi Mumbai**

Samiti heard Dr. Pratik Tambe, President and Shri V.J. Nakil, O.S. on behalf of the aforesaid College/Institute.

The College/Institute has given notice dated 25/02/2013 to the students/parents as per out regulations, but none is present. Notice is produced.

This is in respect of R.G.N.M. course started during Academic Year 2012-13. The fee approved earlier was Rs. 35,000/-. The College/Institute has originally demanded Rs. 69,289/-. The point raised is regarding controlling strength. It is pointed out that College started in Academic Year 2011-12 and hence controlling strength should have been 30 and not 60. There is substance in it. The Institute has now given letter dated 27<sup>th</sup> February 2013 stating that they may be granted fee of Rs. 60,000/-. The demand is quite reasonable and just. We approve the same. Office to take action.

**Item No. 4(3): PGD0013 & BDS0009 – V.Y.W.S. Dental College, Amravati**

Samiti heard Mr. Gulhani, O.S. and Mr. Aditya, Chartered Accountant on behalf of the aforesaid College/Institute.

The College/Institute has given notice dated 11/02/2013 to the students/parents as per out regulations, but none is present. Notice is produced.

The revision is filed in respect of two courses i.e. MDS and BDS started during Academic Year 2012-13.



**BDS:**

The point raised is regarding non consideration of Government Hospital charges and charges of Dr. P.D. Memorial Medical College, Amravati. The fee earlier approved by the Samiti was Rs. 1,95,000/-. The Institute has originally demanded fee of Rs. 2,50,000/-. There is some substance in the point raised. The Institute is now given letter dated 27/02/2013 stating that they may be granted fee of Rs. 2,10,000/-. The demand is quite reasonable. We approve the same. Office to take action.

**MDS:**

The point raised in regarding non consideration of additional expenditure for equipments for Post Graduate courses. There is some substance in it. The Institute has originally demanded fee of Rs. 6,57,000/-. The fee approved was Rs. 2,10,000/-. However now letter dated 27/02/2013 is given stating that they may be allow fee of Rs. 3,10,000/-. The demand is quite reasonable. We allow the same. Office to take action.

**Item No. 4(4): MBBS0004 – MVP's Dr. Vasantao Pawar Medical College, Hospital and Research, Nashik.**

Samiti heard to Mr. R.S. Baste, Chartered Accountant and Mr. A.R. Thakare, Registrar on behalf of the aforesaid College/Institute.

The College/Institute has given notice dated 13/02/2013 to the students/parents as per out regulations, but none is present. Notice is produced.

This is in respect of the MBBS course started during Academic Year 2012-13. The fee earlier approved was Rs. 3,00,000/-. The Institute has originally demanded fee of Rs. 3,55,000/-. The points raised is regarding non consideration of Hospital deficit of



75%. There is some substance in it. As per our norms in this respect, as the Hospital started during 2008-09 it should have been calculated. The Institute has now given a letter dated 27/02/2013 stating that they may be allowed to charge the fee of Rs. 3,30,000/-. This is with view that they may not required a refund. It is quite just and reasonable. Hence we approve the same. Office to take action.

**Item No. 7(a) :** **To consider and decide on the letter dated 25<sup>th</sup> February 2013 received from Maharashtra State Private Nursing Schools and Colleges Management Association, Aurangabad regarding fee fixation of R.A.N.M. and R.G.N.M. courses for the Academic Year 2012-13**

Considered the letter dated 25<sup>th</sup> February 2013 received from Maharashtra State Private Nursing School and Colleges Management Association, Aurangabad endorsed by the Hon'ble Minister Shri Rajesh Tope, Higher and Technical Education Department. The proposals in respect of R.A.N.M. and R.G.N.M. courses could not be finalized, because of



deficiencies pointed out by this office and which are put on the website and not removed. The deficiency mainly related to absence of Government resolution and Permission of Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi (INC). We shall finalize these proposals as and when those deficiencies removed. As on today Samiti office has received 531 proposals for approval of fees structure of R.A.N.M. and R.G.N.M. courses for the Academic Year 2012-13 and we finalized 170 proposals and 361 proposals having certain deficiency.
