Item No. 4 : **To consider and decide the Review Application received from following colleges for approval of fees for AY 2013-14**

Item No. 4(1): **MBBS0010 – Smt. Kashibai Navale Medical College, Narhe, Pune.**

Heard the Institute. The Institute has given the Notice to the students/parents as per our resolution. But none is present on behalf of the students/parents.

The fee approved for MD course is Rs. 5,75,000/- and for MBBS course Rs. 6,30,000/- . It is challenged. But after hearing it is stated that they do not want to press for MD course. They press only for MBBS course. The Institute has originally demanded the fee of Rs. 7,00,000/- it is contended that divisor factor is not taken into consideration correctly. We pointed out that in fact there was mistake on their part in mentioning 500 instead of 450. It is prayed that some increase may be granted considering this aspect. The Institute has now given letter dated 3/1/2014 stating that the fee may be approved at Rs. 6,70,000/- for MBBS course. It is reasonable. We approve the same. Office to declare it.

Item No. 4(2): **BHMS0013 – Dr. J.J. Magdum Homoeopathic Medical College, Jaysingpur, Kolhapur.**

Heard the Institute.

It is prayed that they may be allowed to withdraw the revision. Allowed to withdraw.

Item No. 4(3): **RANM0329- G.S. Nursing School, Sakoli, Bhandara.**

Heard the Institute. The Institute has given the Notice to the students/parents as per our resolution. But none is present on behalf of the students/parents.

The fee approved for the course started during 2012-13 was Rs. 55,000/-. The fee approved for 2013-14 is Rs. 60,000/-. It is challenged mainly on the ground that there is error in making the calculation of expenditure. There seems to be some substance in it. Though the Institute has originally demand fee of Rs. 1,03,936/-. Now they have given the letter dated 3/1/2014 stating that it may be approved at Rs. 65,000/-. It is quite reasonable. We approve the same. Office to declare it.

Item No. 5(a): **To consider and decide on the letter dated 19/11/2013 received from Sant Gajanan Maharaj School of Nursing in respect of consideration of fee approval of RGNM Course. (Ref. Agenda Item No. 3(a) meeting dated 17/09/2013).**

Considered the letter dated 19/11/2013 of the Institute. We correct the error made in the declaration of fee. To be declared for both RANM/RGNM. Office to correct it.

Item No. 5(b): **To consider and decide on the letter dated 22/11/2013 received from Seva Nursing School asking for separate consideration of fee approval of RGNM Course as the proposal was submitted for i.e RANM & RGNM**

both the courses (Ref. Agenda Item No. 3 (a) meeting dated 15/10/2013).

Considered the letter dated 22/11/2013 of the Institute. . We correct the error made in the declaration of fee. To be declared for both RANM/RGNM. Office to correct it.

Item No. 5(c): To consider and decide on the letter dated 9/12/2013 received from GSK School of Nursing (RANM) requesting to allow submission of proposals for approval of fees for the Academic Year 2013-14 (Ref. Agenda Item No. 5 (a) meeting dated 4/12/2013).

Considered the letter dated 9/12/2013 of the Institute . It is to be noted that we have accepted the proposals where there was no permission received by the Institute from Maharashtra Nursing Council and Indian Nursing Council, subject to submitting those permission. Whenever permissions were received and submitted to this office, the fee was declared.

But in this case the Institute has not at all submitted the proposal. It is now pointed out that the permission of the Maharashtra Nursing Council dated 30/9/2013 was received by them on 4/10/2013. Further there was error in sending the permission of Indian Nursing Council. It was sent on the old address. Therefore it was received on 25/10/2013 through post at the corrected address. It is stated that therefore there was delay in submitting the proposal. It is prayed that this may be accepted. Office to accept the proposal subject to receiving penalty of Rs. 30,000/- which was charged in all other cases where there was delay beyond August and upto September 2013.

Item No. 5(d): To consider and decide on the letter dated 13/12/2013 received from Mr. Sahoo in respect of compliance of decision taken in the meeting dated 8/11/2013 (Ref. Agenda Item No. 5(ii) in the meeting dated 8/11/2013).

Considered the letter dated 13/12/2013 of Mr. Sahoo along with the affidavit filed by him. Office to send the same to the Institute and call for the explanation within a period of 4 week .

Item No. 6(a) : To consider and decide on the letter dated 26/11/2013 received from Saraswati Dhanwantari Dental College & Hospital Post Graduate & Research Institute asking permission to charge fees from the repeater students of UG & PG course.

And

Item No. 6(c): To consider and decide on the letter dated 11/12/2013 received from the Director of Medical Education Research, Mumbai in respect of fixation of fees for repeater students of Dadasaheb Surupsingh Nayik Ayurved University , Dhule.



Considered the letter dated 26/11/2013 of the Institute and also of the Medical Education Research, Mumbai dated 11/12/2013. Both these letters are in respect of the fees to be charged by the colleges for repeater students. In this respect we may point out that decision was already taken in the meeting of the Samiti dated 8/11/2013 Item No. (6a) It is as under -

"Considered the letter dated 10/10/2013 received from Dadasaheb Surupsing Naik Ayurvedic Mahavidyalaya, Dhule. It is in respect of fee to be collected from repeater students. The College can collect the fee from such students pro-rata of the failed subjects (for example if the fee is Rs. 1,00,000/- and there are five subjects, if a student fails in two subjects and is required to appear again for those two subjects, then college can charge Rs. 40,000/-) for which they are required to appeared again. The fee is for the course and in case students is not able to complete the course within stipulated time, then College/Institute can charge the fee which is declared for the next course. For example the B.A.M.S. course is 4 ½ years, if the fee declared for Academic Year 2011-12 is Rs. 1,00,000/- then it will continue for 4 ½ years. But thereafter it will apply the fee which is declared for the course started in Academic Year 2015-16. The norm provides as under :-

"1.5 The students admitted in the Academic Year 2013-14 and there after continuing their studies will pay an enhance fee of 5% till the completion of the course (during the stipulated period of the course). For example if the fee is approved is Rs. 1,00,000/- then from IInd years onward till completion of the course i.e. say II, III and IV year the fees will be Rs. 1,05,000/- per @. In case the students take V^h years for completing the course then he shall pay the fee approved in that year."

The actual collection of fees to be done by Institute and Samiti is not concerned with it. Office to inform."

This would apply squarely here and also in all other similar cases.

Item No. 6(b): To consider and decide on the letter dated 4/12/2013 received from Maharashtra University Of Health Sciences, Nashik in respect of representation cum complaints from some students of Dadasaheb Swaroopsingh Naik Ayurved Mahavidyalaya , Nagaon, Dhule demanding exhobitant college fees & other fees.

Considered the letter dated 4/12/2013 of the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik. It requires to be noted that the Samiti only approves the fees. If specific complaint is made of charging more than the approved fee, then the Samiti seek explanation from the Institute. If it is found that the complained is correct than if Samiti asks the college to refund and/or can also recommend the Pravesh Niyrantran Samiti to stop the admissions for the next year of the college. In such cases the students/parents can approach the appropriate authority of the State Government for redressel of their grievance or even for punishment. It is not for the Samiti to oversee other aspects. Office to Communicate.



Item No. 7: **To consider and decide on fees of Colleges who failed to submit their proposals for approval of fee structure for Academic Year 2013-14.**

There is already resolution passed on 10/1/2013 on this subject. It will apply even in this case with only one change i.e. adhoc fee declared for 2013-14 will apply.

Item No. 8: **Discuss and decide about a policy / formula for weeding out papers in Record Room considering space constraints.**

The Office has pointed out the difficulties in storing the papers regarding proposals. There is no space to store them for a long time. Therefore the proposals to be retained in the office for a period of 1 year after the fee is declared by the Samiti on the website. In short they are to be classified in D-papers. But incase if any case is pending before the Samiti or the Court, then it can only be destroyed after completion of the proceedings and 1 year thereafter.

Item No. 9: **Any other matter with the permission to the Chair.**

The Norms number 4.1 for filing revisions is explained as under. It is explained that at the time of hearing revision/review the Samiti shall have a right to re-open the accounts and documents once again. This to be read in Norm No. 4.1.
