Students not being allowed to attend the classes by Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh Memorial Medical College, Amravati.

Considered the letter received from Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik Prof. Dr. Arun Jamkar dated 10/10/2012.

We are sorry to note that the matter mentioned in the said letter was repeatedly heard by the Samiti and after hearing the fee was finalized to



Rs. 4,00,000/-. It was done after going through all the Audited accounts and the connected documents. The college has also paid 6th Pay which is included in it. The fee mentioned of Rs.2,52,500/- was interim fee and was yet to be finalized. It is done as per norms of the Samit. The letter shows that the decision of the Samiti is challenged in the High Court and it is still pending. It is for the students/parents to obtain the stay of the approval of the fee of Rs. 4,00,000/- by the Samiti. They can also obtain the necessary other connected relief from the High Court. It is difficult to understand why they are not moving the High Court for this purpose. We are here with enclosing the reasoned decision of the Samiti dated 16th July 2012. Kindly go through it.
