Applications are invited for Research work.

In terms of Section 13 (1) (iv) of the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and Fees) Act 2015, the Fees Regulatory Authority wishes to assign the work of research studies for determining the professional coursewise expenses required to be made per student for the unaided institutions in accordance with mandatory guidelines of the appropriate authorities concerned and other related and relevant issues. The research work shall cover various financial and regulatory aspects related to fixation of fees for various courses covered under the Act. This will involve comparative study of prevailing fee structure in adjoining state like Gujrat, Madhya Pradesh, Karnataka. Study should also be made to find out reason for disparity in fee structure prevailing in the State of Maharashtra relating to same course / discipline and what possible step can be taken to bridge the gap. Further study should aim at suggesting ideal fee structure in each discipline and legitimate variations, depending upon location of the institute.

The work will be assigned to suitable researcher who

- a. Is well qualified within the field of academics,
- b. has strong research credentials, such as publication and presentation of research papers in National and International Journals and Conferences.
