**For the information of All the Private Professional Educational
Institutions / Colleges.**

Attention of the Dean/Director/Principal of the Private Professional Institute/College is invited to the section of 14(4) of the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and Fees) Act, 2015, it runs thus:

“Every unaided institution shall display on its notice board, the course-wise fees as approved by the Fees Regulating Authority and on its website in Marathi and English, provided that, in case of linguistic minority institutions, the display shall also be in the language of the minority to which such, institution belongs and shall be binding on the students and the institution.”

It has been noticed that many colleges are not observing the above provision. Even UGC guidelines require that the colleges have to notify the details like status, Physical assets and amenities, course-wise sanctioned intake of the students, various types of fees payable for different programmes, total fees payable for an entire programme, last date of admission, details of faculty, members of governing bodies and minutes of the meetings of bodies like Academic/Executive Council, source of income, the financial situation and any other information about its functioning, necessary for an applicant (student) to make a fully informed choice.

Therefore, please ensure that the provision of section 14(4) is scrupulously followed, details are incorporated in the prospectus/brochure, and details are displayed on the website. Please note that breach of the provision may invite heavy penalty as provided under the Law.
