Attention of the students and Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions

Sub: Discloser on the website and prospectus information regarding status...

The University Grant Commission vide its notification dated October, 2018 issued following directions to all Higher Educational Institutions on the captioned subject and other important issues:

All Higher Educational Institutions will be required to disclose on their website and prospectus the information regarding the status, physical assets and amenities, course-wise sanctioned intake of students, various types of fees payable for different programmes, total fees payable for an entire programme, last date of admission, details of faculty, members of governing bodies and minutes of the meetings of bodies like Academic / Executive Council, sources of income, the financial situation and any other information about its functioning, necessary for an applicant (student) to make a fully informed choice.

It further provides that the college/institution should have a Grievance Redressal Mechanism to address the grievance. The notification provides for refund of fees if a student withdraws from the admission programmes depending upon the stage of withdrawal.

It is noticed by the FRA that information displayed by the institutions on their website is either cryptic or insufficient. Such omission violates the student's right to know well in advance the details about the college/institution to enable him to make a proper choice.
